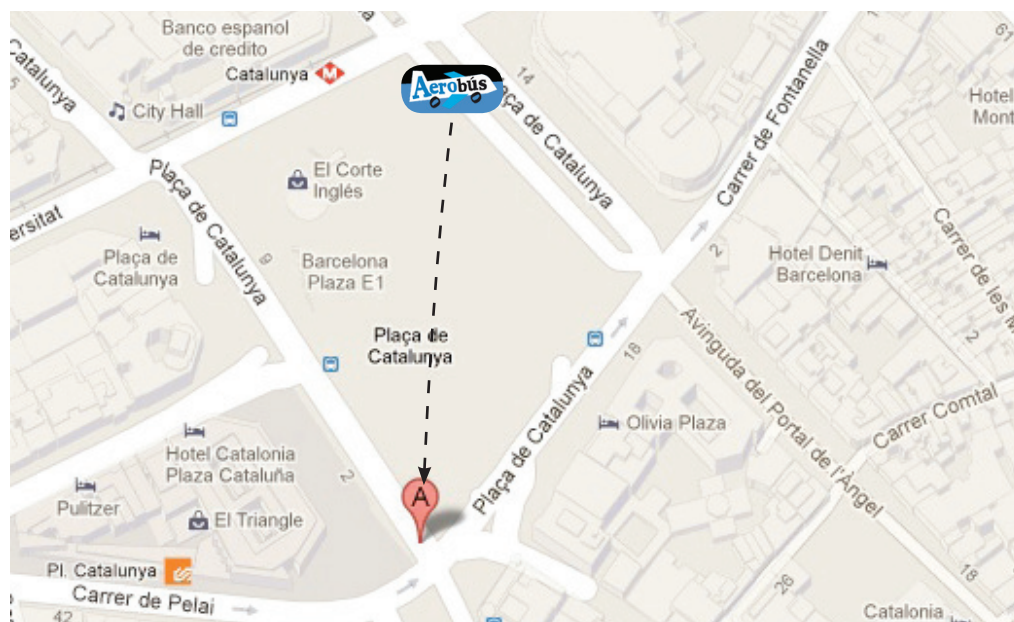
The Generation 1992 campaign is managed by P.A.U. Education, a company dedicated to increasing youth participation and social engagement.



How to get from the Barcelona El Prat Airport to In & Out Hostel?

- 1 Take the Aerobus to Plaça Catalunya (final stop). The buses leave and return from the two airport terminals (T1 or T2) every 5 or 10 minutes, from 6:00 AM to 1:00 AM, all 365 days. The ticket is 5,65 EUR.*

- 2 Cross Plaça Catalunya to catch the suburban train FGC (Ferrocarrils de la Generalitat). You need to find the train entry that is in front of Café Zurich.

The lines are:

S1 or S2 to **Baixador de Vallvidrera**. << This is your stop



- 3 When you arrive at the station of Baixador de Vallvidrera you have to take the right exit towards Carrer Major del Rector et and follow the road to the right. In & Out Hostel is only a few minutes away from this stop, climbing up the mountain. You need to follow the signs that say IN & OUT. It will be a 10-15 minute walk (500 steps).

*All costs of the airport to the hostel itinerary will be reimbursed. Keep your tickets!
